

Things to do and not to do with a Smart Start device

_____ **Do not** drink alcohol such as beer, wine, whiskey, liquor, or any other type of alcoholic beverage before blowing into a Smart Start device.

_____ **Do not** use any cough medicines or mouthwash - and be careful of certain gel toothpastes.

_____ **Do not** eat food just prior to taking a test with a Smart Start device.

_____ **Do not** drink high energy drinks/soda/sweet tea prior to taking a test with a Smart Start Device.

_____ **Always** rinse your mouth with WATER prior to blowing into a Smart Start Device.

_____ You must become a label reader before consumption of any product that may contain alcohol. Look for any word that ends in the letters "OL". That product ingredient contains some form of alcohol.

_____ Exercise caution with the use of oxygen tanks, inhalers, and electronic cigarettes.

_____ **Never** blow smoke from cigarettes into units - because a tar like film may form inside the unit. This can cause problems with the unit.

_____ **Never** use smokeless tobacco products (Snuff and Chewing Tobacco) while using a Smart Start Device. This can cause blockage inside the unit.

_____ **Never** use any products around the unit such as hand sanitizer, body spray, perfume, hair spray, cologne, cleaners, air fresheners, or gasoline (can contain up to 10% alcohol).

_____ Again, **always** rinse your mouth with water before blowing into the device. You may wait a few minutes before taking a test. Remember you have FIVE MINUTES to complete a rolling retest.

_____ Maintain your vehicle at all times. Faulty batteries, charging systems, and poor maintenance can cause problems with your Smart Start device.

_____ **Never** leave the Smart Start device on the floor or dash of your vehicle. Dirt and Extreme Heat or Cold can cause damage to the device.

_____ Remember YOU are responsible for the care of the Smart Start Device at all times.

_____ Remember YOU are responsible for all tests completed on the device, including fails caused by contaminants that you (or another driver) have consumed or inhaled. Any violations due to alcohol readings will result in a lockout fee charge.
